



Cerdanya/Cerdagne



Covering an area of more than 1,300 km2, the Cerdanya high plateau is one of the most extensive valleys in Europe (average altitude of 1,000 m).

It has a population of around 33,000.

An economy based on tourism which leads to an increase in population in August and during the ski season (up to 4 times).

A difficult climate in winter (snow and bad weather) complicates access to the region by road.

North/south cultural similarities. Recent and very "porous" border (Treaty of the Pyrenees 1659)



One obstacle but One solution

Based on the Framework Agreement between France and Spain on cross-border health cooperation signed in Zaragoza on 27 June 2008.

Agreements between the ARS (French state) and the Spanish Autonomous communities.

Partnership agreements between medical orders to enable crossborder emergency health intervention.

Improvement of emergency healthcare for the 15 millions inhabitants of the Pyrenees.

3Land – what's that?


 an area of 430 ha in the heart of the trinational agglomeration of Basel

(Weil am Rhein, Huningue, Basel)

 a development and transformation area due to structural change

 a cross-border district, a living and work space for 20.000 people

→Focus on mobility + infrastructures and open space + ecological sites

- presentation of the basic idea

How?

guided tour by foot and by boat

• 2 guides "in disguise", representing the past and the future

Why?

• to (re)discover the project area

to connect past and future

to encourage discussions

- at busy public places in the three cities
- activating survey open discussion

Why?

- to gather the perceptions, impressions and emotions of the populations
- to reach out to those who do not participate in conventional participatory processes


